


HSH Princess Angelika Ewa Jarosławska Sapieha.

International Peace Ambassador, anti-landmine activist, Patron over the global demining action, humanitarian, philanthropist.

International Peace Ambassador by SPIA HSD Soldiers of Peace International Association Humanitarian Support and Development, United Nations Peacekeepers NGO's with General Consultative Status of the United Nations Economic and Social Council. Initiator and patron of the global "One Mine One Life" campaign and movement towards a mine-free world.

Honorary Ambassador and member of the Polish Peace Corps. Global ant-landmine activist, peace activist, humanitarian. Initiator and coordinator of economic projects that promote culture and history. Patron of the Cambodia Landmine Museum, Cambodian Self Help Demining, Landmine Relief Fund and Roots of Peace.



Peace Ambassador Princess Angelika Ewa Jarosławska Sapieha mobilizes the international community to support the international anti-landmine campaign, demining organizations in Cambodia and raising awareness about the "underground devil" – millions of landmines that are still lying active in the ground around the world. Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha is the head of the Geopolitical Alliance of Women Board. She took the patronage over the exhibition "Children in War", which had its premieres in seventeen countries, as well as in the European Parliament and the headquarters of the United Nations in New York. Initiator of the "Children Painting Peace" international contest.

Together with the leaders from Ukraine, Georgia and Syria, she initiated on May 30, 2019, the "Geopolitics Balance Women's Platform" to support international peace and human rights. In 2019 she received the Saint Stanislaw's Order established by Polish King Stanisław August Poniatowski for her contribution to culture and social activities. She was chosen as a one of the "30 under 30" by Forbes magazine.

On September 30th, 2019 in Chennai, India, Peace Ambassador Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha received Honorary Award due to her continuous support to humanity. In 2016 in Poland, Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha received the Multicultural Leader award. In 2017 She was also chosen as a one of the 21 women in the book published on the 100th anniversary of women gaining the right to vote in Poland. This book was presented at WED Day – World Women's Entrepreneurship Day in New York and Polish Special Award of Intelligent Development. She was chosen to be a one of the hundred Polish women, which were a symbol of the 100th anniversary of women's right to vote in Poland.



For her lifetime achievements in humanitarian and social work, in 2020 Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha received a special Super Wiktoria award as an "International Ambassador for the Implementation of the UN Sustainable Development Goals". In August 2020, the former Blues Helmets meeting in Committee, awarded Princess Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha by the Commemorative Medal of Peace. Commemorative medal of peace has rendered eminent services for the noble cause of Peace and the dignity of man, in order to obtain a better world, by promoting Justice, International Law, and Social Progress.

In 2021 World Humanitarian Drive (WHD) conferred the *Global Humanitarian Award* to HSH Princess Angelika Ewa Jarosławska Sapieha, International Peace Ambassador for her contributions as an leader in serving global communities in need and putting humanity first.

On October 9, 2021 Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha received a special award Super Wiktoria for ther humanitarian work and contribution to the global demining action as an "International Peace Ambassador and Leader in the Global Anti-landmine Campaign".

In 2022 Princess Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha organized a special event 'One Mine One Life Worldwide Movement for Mine-free World' on the NGO CSW66 Forum, assisting the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women. The event took place in New York City, USA on 21st of March 2022. In June 2022 Princess Angelika Jarosławska Sapieha received a special medal 'Star of Cambodia' from United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia (UNTAC). for her long- standing humanitarian support for Cambodia and support for demining action in Cambodia.


